Welcome

I am glad you are here because I am calling you in at this very moment. My words have always been the same. I plea to everyone, everywhere.

“Today if you hear my voice” and to My delight, you are here, reading this invitation.

I perceive you have been searching for something more and that is what brought you here today.

There is a quiet thought within you saying, “This is not where my life should be.” So today I invite you to come. I am not waiting for you to fix yourself before you come. I am asking you to come and lay it all before me.

“Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.” (Matthew 11:28)

I see the weight upon you; life is taking you down a path of resistance and yet you have tried to be better. You have made promises to yourself that you failed to keep. You feel like a heavy hand is upon you. Maybe you feel the pressure of knowing what is right and still falling short.
